

First 2014 Cadillac ELR (Volt based electric-gas hybrid) Rolls off the Line



IndyCar driver Simona De Silvestro christened the first 2014 Cadillac ELR to roll off the line at the Detroit-Hamtramck plant in Michigan on Wednesday. The Volt-based electric-gas hybrid will go on sale next year.

The ELR uses a 16.5-kilowatt-hour battery that offers electric travel for up to 35 miles. The 1.4-liter gasoline generator can power the battery to extend the range to 300 miles. Cadillac says total system output is 207 hp and 295 lb-ft of torque.
